Foundation Degree in Leadership and Management

ILM and the University of Hertfordshire have developed a new approach to degree qualifications, designed to give practising or aspiring middle managers a broad grounding in leadership & management in a business or organisation. It is delivered through online & work based learning to develop a range of leadership and management skills, both formally and through self directed efforts. Programmes are split into modules, each with a blend of online learning, videos, readings and practical activities. Students submit reflective diaries, from which they receive regular feedback, and these also form the basis of their assessment.

Student activities

Students study in a variety of ways, including classroom, case study, online etc. Learning is always practical, leading to assessments that encourage application and measurement of results. The programme is delivered through our partner centres, who have passed through stringent quality assurance processes to show themselves as truly excellent in their fields. Students complete work based projects, aimed at helping them achieve results for themselves and their organisations.

The course

Over the two years of the programme, students study for two ILM Extended Diplomas, one each at levels 4 and 5. In each year, they cover six themes, namely Leadership; Management; People; Finance; Entrepreneurship and Marketing; and Work based Learning. Assessment is continuous, with students submitting a series of reflective reviews and assignments based on application of their learning. Successful students will be awarded both the ILM Diplomas and the Foundation Degree in Leadership and Management
