

ILM Level 2 Team Leading

The ILM Level 2 Award and ILM Level 2 Certificate in Team Leading programmes are designed to give Team Leaders a solid foundation for their formal development as a leader. They are delivered through online and work based learning to develop a range of leadership and management skills, both formally and through their own self directed efforts. Programmes are split into modules, each with a blend of online learning, videos, readings and practical activities. Students submit reflective diaries, from which they receive regular feedback, and these also form the basis of their assessment.

The Award

The Award is a concise qualification designed to give learners a basic knowledge of the various roles, functions and responsibilities of a Team Leader and the limits of their authority and accountability. It includes an initial foundation unit, Developing Yourself as a Team Leader, which is a good starting point for those who are new to the role or for aspiring leaders who wish to gain a solid understanding of the principles and practicalities of team leading.

The Certificate

The Certificate builds and broadens the skills and knowledge gained through the Award, which acts as its first module and does not have to be taken separately. The programme looks at practical techniques in motivating teams, planning and monitoring, running projects, communicating, identifying and achieving impacts and personal development.
